ItalAfrica can:

- Undertake, organize, sponsor and facilitate all activities of an economic, cultural, social and scientific character to deepen mutual understanding and to establish links of friendship between Italy, the countries of Central Africa in general and the DRC in particular;
- Organise meetings, conferences and other events, promote studies and market researches; stimulate the participation of traders in fairs and exhibitions; organise missions of operators from and to the DRC and the Central African countries, to develop other actions designed to increase Italian economic relations with Africa and to raise mutual awareness of the characteristics of the industrial, agricultural, commercial and tourist sectors, to promote technology transfer and exchange of goods and services, to promote the establishment of joint enterprises;

Submit to the competent authorities and, in particular, to the diplomatic and consular authorities of the countries concerned, initiatives that might facilitate the development of economic relations between Italy and the DRC and Central African countries;

- Extend all the possible assistance for the definition of a dispute between Italian and African subjects, particularly within the system of Conciliation, Arbitration and Expertise of the Euro African Chambers of Commerce;
- Create a documentation center that can detect and disseminate laws and regulations in force in Italy and in the DRC and Central African countries and all the data and news, particularly economic, financial and commercial ones, which are linked to the purpose of the Association;
- Promote editorial initiatives for the publication of journals, monographs, yearbooks of the Chamber or related to relations between Italy and Africa;
- Perform other activities that the social organs consider useful and appropriate or instrumental to achieve the purposes and the development of the Association.
